Your rights

You can exercise the following rights at any time using the above given contact details:

- Right of access by the data subject (Art. 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (‘right to be forgotten’) (Art. 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to object (Art. 21 GDPR)

If you have given us your consent, you can revoke it at any time with future effect.

You can contact a supervisory authority at any time with a complaint, e.g. B. to the competent supervisory authority of the country or state of your residence or to the authority responsible for us as the responsible body.

Information Collection and Use

Our primary goals in collecting and using information is to manage our members' accounts and organize our events, contact you, conduct research and create reports for internal use. All information that is collected is expressly given by you during your registration process as member or event participant. By submitting your information you agreed with the collection and processing of your data.

Our information is stored and hosted on servers from www.yapla.fr and <https://all-inkl.com/>.

All data are only accessible to and used by the AASE Executive Board in power. Member data are accessible to other members too. No data is shared with third parties.

We do not use your data to draw conclusions about you personally. Information of this type may be statistically evaluated by us in order to optimize our website and the technology behind it.

Storage period

Data will be deleted as soon as it is no longer required for the purpose of the collection.

This is generally the case for the data used to provide the website when the respective session has ended.

Members' data are deleted latest 5 years after a member left AASE for whatever reason.

Event participants' data are deleted latest 5 years after the event except of a new event participation that restarts the storage period.

Payment data are stored as long as legal requirements make it necessary.

Provision of chargeable services

We will ask for additional data to provide services that are subject to charge, e.g. payment details in order to be able to execute your order or participation.

The processing of the data required for the provision of the chargeable service is based on Art. 6 Par. 1 lit. b GDPR. All payment actions are done using the platform www.yapla.fr that is an agent of the French payment service provider Lemon Way (<https://www.lemonway.com/en/terms-and-conditions/>).

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that we transfer to your computer and/or device, to identify a user's computer/device and to "remember" things (details) about your visit, such as your preferences or a username and password. Information contained in a cookie may be linked to your personal information, such as your user ID, for purposes such as improving the quality of our Services, tailoring recommendations to your interests, and making the Services easier to use. You can disable cookies at any time, although you may not be able to access or use features of the Services.
